[B] Brief rules for Students' Union Election 2016-17.

1. The whole process of the said election of the college should be completed latest by 31st January,2017.
2. The students who have satisfactory attendance in the present year / semester may file their nominations and also cast votes.
3. The students who have academic arrear but have got promoted to the next year/semester may be considered as bonafide students of the promoted semester/class.
4. Nomination form should be submitted by the candidate independently.

5. In case of withdrawal of nomination/candidature duly filled-in application as prescribed by the competent authority should be submitted individually.
6. The Nomination Forms can be downloaded by the interest candidates/students from the website of the college. The hard copy of the said forms may also be obtained from the college office.
7. Hard copy of the duly filled-in nomination forms in all respect along with photographs can be submitted by individuals in the college office in due course of time. No nomination will be accepted after the expiry of the time and date of submission.
8. Undergraduate regular students between the age of 17 and 22 years may contest elections. The maximum age limit for postgraduate regular students to legitimately contest the election would be 25 years.
9. The candidates shall in no event have any academic arrears in the year contesting the elections.
10. The candidate must be regular, full-time student of the college and should not be a distance/proximate education/add on course student.
